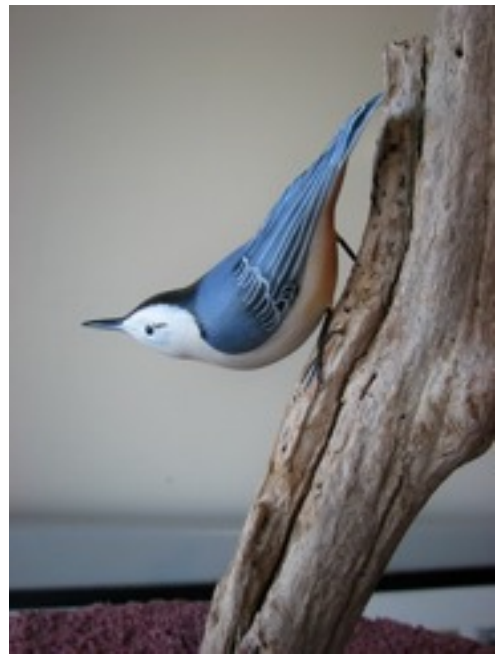


Newsletter April 2010
