

# **Champagne Division Rules**

## **“Special” Class for the April 13, 2013 Show**

**Entries must:**

- **Fit within a 3 ¼” circle.**
- **Be carved from wood.**

**This division will be divided into two categories:**

**1. Floating**

- Self-righting is not a requirement.
- Anything goes: birds or general, be creative.
- During the show, each floating entry will be displayed in its own partially water filled champagne glass (to be provided by the club). Be aware of this requirement when finishing your piece.

**2. Non-Floating**

- Anything goes: birds or general.
- Be creative.

**Members may enter this class FREE of charge; multiple entries are allowed.**

**This division will award ribbons in both the Floating and Non-Floating categories.**

Note: The designated champagne glass\* holds four ounces and stands approximately 4 ¼ inches high, 3 inches of which is stem and base. The diameter of the bowl measures 3 ¼ inches. At its deepest point, the bowl depth is 1 ¼ inches. For the carvers' edification, a champagne glass and a copy of these rules will be available during club meetings. Please take one to use as a reference while creating your entry. Remember to bring the glass to the show along with your entry in May. Extras will be available on site.
